Total tuition cost: \$4,800

Tuition Payment Options

1. One time full payment of \$4,800 (Due by August 15)
2. You may pay \$2,400 by August 15, 2024 and the remaining \$2,400 by January 15, 2025

Late Payments

If a payment is missed, you will have 24 hours to contact us to rectify payment. If we are not contacted within 24 hours and a solution has not been made, a \$50 late fee will be added to the balance owed. If payment is not resolved within 30 days, Union University Mobile reserves the right to suspend you from attending the university.

By signing our financial agreement, you agree to pay the full year of tuition regardless of whether you attend for the full year unless otherwise released from this obligation by the leadership of Union University. If you are suspended or expelled from the UUM for any reason, you will still be required to fulfill the full year of tuition.

Dress Code

Our dress code will be relaxed but we still ask that you dress appropriately.

- No clothing should show undergarments.
- No clothing with inappropriate symbols, messages, or language.
- Leggings are permitted as long as it is paired with a top long enough to cover the backside (this pertains to biker shorts as well).
- No halter tops, low cut tops, bare midriffs, or off the shoulder tops.
- Shorts are permitted with at least a 5" inseam for both boys and girls and no excessive tightness. If you wear running shorts, you will need to have biker shorts underneath.

Absences & Tardies

Our daily sessions at UUM ARE NOT optional. You are expected to attend each session for its duration on time. We will also require that you attend our weekly Friday night gatherings, Tuesday morning prayers, and Reunion gatherings.

If you will be absent, please email us as soon as possible. If you have more than 2 unreported absences, you may be required to attend a meeting with leadership to discuss the importance of attendance and reporting absences as well as any potential plans of corrective actions moving forward.
